2006 Pinot Noir



The 2006 season was very warm and dry and the pinot noir grapes were picked on 16th March 2006 which was the earliest picking date in the twenty-six year history of Narkoojee. The fruit quality was excellent with good acid retention.

- Colour: Deep, black cherry red with vibrant crimson edges
- Bouquet: Intense with red bramble fruits, black cherry and notes of raspberry and spice
- Flavour: Black cherry and ripe blood plum with spicy oak
- Texture: Finely grained tannins giving the sensation of crushed velvet, carrying the flavours through to a long finish
- Alcohol: 14.5%
